

How to Get a *Secret Sisters Society* Cancer Screening

WHO is eligible?

The **Secret Sisters Society** program is for women, age 40-49 who would otherwise be unable to afford an annual screening for breast or cervical cancer. United Health Services, the local administrator of the Indiana Breast & Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP), qualifies women for the program and their staff may also direct women to other available health care resources. HOW are these mammograms funded?

The money is raised through the annual **Secret Sisters Society** Luncheon & Style Show, presented by the **Women's Task Force of Saint Joseph Health System** each year. Additional money comes from the purchase of **Secret Sisters Society** memberships by friends in the community and donations made to the fund by other individuals, groups or businesses.

WHO helps with this program?

Other partners in this program include **United Health Services/Indiana Breast & Cervical Cancer Program** and the providers who offer **Secret Sisters** screenings, including Saint Joseph Health System (Mishawaka, Plymouth, South Bend & the Mobile Medical Unit), Elkhart General Hospital, Memorial Hospital, Radiology, Inc. and XRC Medical Imaging.

WHO started this program?
